- Horse must be a Registered Arabian or Half/Anglo Arabian.
- Submit this form no later than November 15 of the program year.
- Show secretary from EACH show must verify placing with their signature.
- All information must be provided and legible.
- Competition year is from November 1 through October 31.
- The same rider must ride the same horse. One horse/One rider combination.
- Performance classes which count: Halter, Showmanship, Pleasure, Trail, Equitation, Reining and Driving
- Sport Horse classes which count: Dressage, Sport Horse Under Saddle, Working Hunter, Hunter Hack, Jumper, Equitation, Sport Horse in Hand, Show Hack.

Region V Arabian Horse Association Open Show High Point Award Rules

- Any person riding a registered Arabian or Half/Anglo Arabian horse who competes at open shows is eligible.
- Placing's earned in AHA Recognized A, B, or C Arabian Shows DO NOT COUNT.
- Champion and Reserve Champion Awards will be given each year for each of the following age brackets: 13 & under, 14-17, 18-39, 40 and over.
- The competition year is from November 1 through October 31.
- Points are awarded for one horse/one rider combination. The same rider must ride the horse in every class from which points are counted. Performance classes which count: Halter, Showmanship, Pleasure, Trail, Equitation, Reining and Driving. Sport Horse classes which count: Dressage, Sport Horse Under Saddle, Working Hunter, Hunter Hack, Jumper, Equitation, Sport Horse in Hand, Show Hack.
- Points are earned as follows: one point is earned for each horse defeated in a class. For example: 1st place out of 10 horses = 9 points, 2nd place = 8 points, 3rd place = 7 points, 4th place = 6 points, and 5th place = 5 points.
- Only placings 1st through 5th count for points. One horse classes do not earn points.
- The participant is responsible for keeping his/her results on the office form. No other forms will be accepted.
- Placings for which points are earned must be verified by the show secretary of that show.
- Completed, verified forms must be postmarked by November 15 of each year.
- Winners will be notified by December 15 and prizes will be awarded at the January meeting of the Region 5 Arabian Horse Club.
- There is no cost to compete for these awards.
