General Rules

Classes will be run on the ticket system. When you pay for classes you will be given a ticket to give to the gate person as you enter the class.

No Minors (17 & under) are allowed to handle Stallions in any class.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: We strongly encourage all riders to wear protective headgear passing current applicable ASTM standards with harnesses secured while riding anywhere on the grounds.

Hunt riders 17 & under are required to wear a helmet.

Show management has the right to refuse service or entry to any person or animal. Judge's decisions are Final!!!!

Show clothes are encouraged. Those wearing show clothes will be looked at more favorably.

But dressing in your discipline is necessary.

ATTIRE/NUMBERS: Exhibitors must appear in the ring suitably attired with correct number, clearly visible to the judge at all times when in competition. Entries with missing numbers will be eliminated.

Novice riders or horses not to have won more than 3-1st place ribbons in that particular division during his or her show career.

CHECKS RETURNED FOR ANY REASON INCURE A \$50 SERVICE CHARGE and future entries will need to be by money order or cash only; personal checks will not be accepted by these exhibitors.

ENTRIES must be in writing, signed by owner/authorized agent, & accompanied by proper fees. Parent/Guardian must sign the entry of a junior exhibitor. No refunds. Open checks are accepted.

Schooling Please limit schooling of horses. Stay in the gait announced during all classes. This is an "open show".

Saddle Type are Arab, Morgan, Saddlebred etc. breeds / **Stock Type** are Quarter Horses, TB, Paint, Appy etc. breeds

Colored Horse - Color breed horses (buckskin, Pinto etc.) / **Solid Horse** - horses other than color breeds

JUNIOR / SENIOR PAIR: (2 riders, 1 horse) 1st rider 19 & Over entry direction, 2nd rider 18 & Under for the reverse.

STABLING: Two bales of shavings will be supplied. Additional bedding is available for a fee of \$7 per bale.

Horse or tack Stalls \$27 day or \$47 for the weekend arriving Friday **not before** 2pm leaving Sunday, Office will close Friday night at 8pm. RV \$25 for pwr/water or \$20 a night w/o hookup. If you stay in your RV even if you don't hook up we will be charged by the grounds and we will pass the charge on to you. Classes are \$9 each.
